Personal Protective Equipment

Course Outline

The course is designed to provide participants with the skills and confidence to meet the requirements of the guidelines and regulations, relating to the management of the safety of the workplace and the documentation required.

This course is classroom based; it is highly interactive with roleplaying and practical examples to reinforce understanding and learning.

Course Outcomes

Employers are primarily responsible for creating and maintaining a safe and healthy workplace. The aim of this course is to understand how to manage and conduct all work activities so as to ensure as reasonably as practicable the safety, health and welfare of people at work. In the meantime the employer will acquire competencies about the legal responsibilities of his role, in reference to all working activities and risks in the workplace.



Course Structure

Entry Requirements

- Basic level of English (reading, understanding and spoken English)
- Basic knowledge of computer for research (MS Word and Internet Browsing)
- Basic numerical skills

Learning Objectives

At the end of this course the candidate would have acquired:

- Understand the correct method to manage prevention measures that can be taken to minimize risk in a workplace.
- Understand the law regarding the use of PPE.
- Acquire the knowledge of the various types of PPE.
- Recognise common safety hazards where PPE is required.
- Be acquainted under what conditions each level of PPE should be used.
- Know the different types of equipment in each level of PPE, and the features and capabilities of each type.
- Recognize the critical importance of keeping safe while working with different types of hazardous materials.
- Understand the principles of maintaining PPE in good condition.
- Examine workplace conditions to make sure they conform to available PPE.
- Apply procedures to prevent and minimize safety risks.
- Follow the procedures established for each type of hazard in the workplace.
- Apply maintenance and safety controls to PPE.
