Award in Basic Tile Laying Techniques

Course Outline

The training course is intended to give the necessary knowledge, skills and competences to someone wishing to work in the building and construction sector. It is specifically focusing on basic tile laying knowledge and skills. Individuals seeking to work in the Building and Construction sector either as part of a larger company with different skills specialisation or else in a small company or as a self-employed where multiple skills within the same sector might be necessary.

Course Outcomes

This course seeks to promote the understanding of safe procedures and safe work practices to ensure that their actions do not create health and safety risks to self and others, identify risks and hazards associated with the working environment, tools and equipment and materials and substances used. The learner will build knowledge and skills of the necessary preparations prior to work being conducted and identifying the different materials used for both installation and service and maintenance work. The learner will also focus on applying dimensions from drawings and calculating quantities in the preparation, costing and estimation. Furthermore, the course will also look at selecting and using hand tools in a correct and safe manner.



Course Structure

Total of 50 hours

Various Course Structure options made up of:

- Theory, and
- Practical

Self-Study

A reading list will be provided through handouts during the duration of the course.

Selection from;

- Oral Examination (30 minutes),
- Practical Examination (60 minutes) and
- Multiple Choice Examination (90minutes).

Entry Requirements

School leaving certificate or a minimum of 5 years work experience

Learning Objectives

The learner will be able to:

- Outlines the preventative and remedial actions to be taken in the case of exposure to materials hazardous to health.
- Reports any hazards which may present risk to relevant persons.
- States the basic properties of fixings including masonry, concrete and timber.
- Confirms that all materials, tools and equipment necessary for the installation process are available as required.
- Confirms that all material, tools and equipment are fit for their intended purpose.
- Understands and explains the correct procedure for setting out work systems.

The learner will be able to:

- Identify instances where additional information would be necessary and liaise with supervisor accordingly;
- Look for information, directions and guidance in the use of materials and tools
