Threats to fire safety are referred to as fire hazards. A fire hazard may include a situation that increases the likelihood a fire may start or may impede escape in the event a fire occurs.

Every workplace must have a number of fire marshals to assist other fellow workers and other personnel in case of an emergency. This course is for those interested / assigned to act on behalf of the management as fire marshals during working hours.
