

## **S025 Health and Safety – Scaffolding – Safe Use**

### **Course Outline:**

The course will endeavour to consolidate practical experience acquired on site by giving a theoretical insight to such experience. Without going much into mathematics, the course will endeavour to expose and explain the benefits of best practice methods required for proper operation and use of scaffold systems.
